The prescribed font sizes are: Title - 16 points, Author's Name - 11 points, Affiliation and Email - 10 points, Abstract and Keywords - 10 points, Heading1 - 12 points, Heading2 - 11 points, Figure/Table Captions - 11 points, Body Texts - 10 points, References Heading - 10 points, and Reference Texts - 8 points.

It is advised to make ‘Abstract’, ‘Introduction’ and ‘Conclusion’ very brief/short by highlighting the main information and/or contribution. The authors may elaborate a bit more on ‘Methodology’ and ‘Findings’ within the page limit (One to Two pages). Please limit the number of Figures/Graphs/Pictures to Max FIVE (5), and Tables to Max TWO (2) only. The table and figure captions should be placed above the tables and under the figures respectively. The table, figure and reference numbers must be mentioned/inserted/cited in the body text along with their description as per necessity.




Figure 1. Example of figure for the extended abstract
